

## Parking Lots

- Use of the parking lots is for MFD patrons who have purchased a seasonal or weekly parking pass.
- Parking passes are sold only to MFD residents/ taxpayers.
- Parking passes can be purchased at the MFD Fire Station 65 Crandall Avenue on designated weekends.
- Unauthorized vehicles left in the parking lots after 6:00pm will be towed at the owner's expense.
- Misuse, violations, or forgery of any pass will result in forfeiture of beach/parking privileges.
- Parking passes should be hung from the rear view mirror. Please be sure your parking pass is clearly visible to MFD personnel.

### Garbage Pickup Schedule:

**Throughout the entire year**  
garbage pickup is weekly every  
Wednesday.

**Saturday and Wednesday  
pickup service** begins on the  
3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of June and ends  
on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday of September.

#### **Please note:**

Household trash must be in Town of Westerly orange garbage bags and placed in garbage cans.

Recyclables must be in a separate container. Recyclables may be co-mingled (paper, glass, plastic and aluminum cans).

Trash needs to be ready for pickup by 7:00am on pick up day.

**PLEASE do not** place garbage or recyclables at the curb. The hauler provides the district with at house pickup.

## Our Beaches

### Operating Hours:

**Weekdays 10:00am-6:00pm**

**Weekends 9:00am-6:00pm**

**Holidays 9:00am-6:00pm**

- Clark Farms, Benson and Lawton beaches are private MFD properties for use by MFD residents, property owners, and their guests.
- All patrons must be in possession of a walk on pass for access to MFD beaches and facilities. Passes must be visible at all times. **Passes, both parking and walk on, will be required on opening day.**
- Be respectful and neat in the use of the bathroom facilities.
- Please remove all trash when leaving the beach and place in the designated receptacles. Please recycle!
- MFD beaches are cleaned and groomed daily. **Do not drop off chairs and or towels before opening time as they may be damaged or removed during cleanup.**
- Please keep off the fenced in area of the dunes as beach restoration is still in progress.

## Rules & Regulations

- No animals at any time.
- No surf boarding, skim boarding, ball playing, frisbee throwing, or any activity that may endanger beach patrons. Small plastic boards (Boogie boards) used for body surfing are allowed at the Lifeguard's discretion.
- No alcoholic beverages or drugs; violators will be asked to leave MFD property and may be subject to arrest by Westerly Police Department. Management has the right to inspect cooler contents or bags.
- No glass containers on the beach.
- No smoking on the beach (this includes electronic cigarettes).
- No hole can be deeper than 2 feet. Holes must be filled in and sand castles taken down before patrons leave the beach.
- No tents or canopies are allowed. Small "igloos" used for protection of infants are allowed only along the fence line.
- No fires or fireworks permitted at any time.
- All music must be played only through earphones or personal listening devices.
- No fishing allowed during beach hours.

## Lifeguards

- Instructions of Lifeguards and MFD personnel will be obeyed while on MFD property.
- All injuries should be reported to the nearest Lifeguard immediately.
- A missing person should be reported to the nearest Lifeguard immediately.
- MFD recommends that patrons swim only when Lifeguards are on duty.
- Please do not sit in front of Lifeguard chairs; a clear path to the water must be maintained.
- No Lifeguards or MFD personnel are on duty after 6:00pm.
