# **Parking Lots**

- The parking lots are for MFD residents & property owners who have purchased seasonal or weekly parking passes.
- Parking passes & walk on tags will be available at the Fire Station on the 3rd & 4th weekend in May and the 1st weekend in June from 9:00 am-1:00 pm.
- Parking passes must be hung from the rear view mirror and be clearly visible to beach staff.
- Misuse and/or forgery of passes will result in forfeiture of beach privileges.
- Cars in the parking lots after 6:00 pm will be locked in until the following day. Owners may have their vehicle towed at their own expense. Repeat violations will result in the forfeiture of your parking pass.

#### **Garbage Pickup**

**Garbage Pickup Schedule:** Year round pick up for the entire district is on Wednesdays. Summer Saturday pickup begins on the 3rd Saturday in June and ends on the 2nd Saturday of September.

- All trash must be placed in Town of Westerly orange bags and contained in proper garbage cans.
- All recyclables must be in a blue container marked for recyclables. Recycles can be co-mingled paper, glass, plastic & cans.
- Trash should be ready for pickup by 7:00am on the scheduled pickup days.
- PLEASE Do Not place garbage at the curb or at the end of the driveway.
   Collection is backyard or side yard pick up.

## **Our Beaches**

#### Operating Hours: Weekdays 10:00am-6:00pm Weekends 9:00am-6:00pm Holidays 9:00am-6:00pm

- Clark Farms, Benson and Lawton beaches are private MFD properties for the use of MFD residents, property owners & their guests.
- All patrons must be in possession of a beach tag or hotel tag to gain access to MFD beaches. Beach tags should be on your person at all times.
   Parking passes, and beach tags, will be required on opening day.
- Be respectful and neat in the use of the bathroom facilities.
- Please remove all trash when leaving beaches and place in designated receptacles. Please recycle!
- Please be aware, beaches are cleaned daily. Do not drop off chairs or towels before the opening times as they will be damaged and/or moved during tractor cleanup.
- Please keep off the fenced in area of the dunes as restoration is in progress.

#### **Rules & Regulations**

For the enjoyment of everyone, please note what is **NOT ALLOWED on MFD Beaches.** 

Alcohol, Animals, Ball or Frisbee throwing, Fires, Fireworks, Glass, Grilling, Skim Boards, Smoking, Surf Boarding, Canopies, Tents or any activity considered to be endangering beach patrons. Violators will be escorted off MFD property and maybe subject to arrest by Westerly Police.

- Small foam or plastic boards (Boogie boards) used for body surfing are allowed at the Lifeguard's discretion.
- No hole can be deeper than
  1ft. Holes must be filled in and sand
  castles taken down before patrons
- Small "igloos" used for protection of infants are only allowed along the back fence line.
- Music must be played only through personal listening devices.
- Fishing is not allowed during beach hours.
- Please be respectful and do not harm or feed the seagulls.

### **Lifequards**

- Please do not sit in front of lifeguard stations. A clear path to the water must always be maintained.
- Instructions of lifeguards and MFD employees must be obeyed at all times.
- All injuries should be reported to the nearest lifeguard and beach manager immediately.
- A missing person should be reported to the nearest lifeguard and beach manager.
- MFD recommends that you swim only when lifeguards are on duty.
- All MFD staff and lifeguards are off duty at 6:00pm. The facilities close at 5:45pm sharp for cleaning. The parking gates are locked at 6:00 pm.
